Their marriage at York Factory on 4 September 1815 by James Sutherland, an elder authorized by the Church of Scotland to baptize and marry, is recorded in the journal of Sheriff Alexander Macdonell (PAM, Selkirk Papers - MG2A1 - Reel M187, page 17959).
